Mansfield ISD Google Apps for Education Permission Form for Students Under 13

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are excited to announce that Mansfield ISD will be using Google Apps for Education for teachers and students. This permission form describes the tools and student responsibilities for using these services. As with any educational endeavor, a strong partnership with families is essential to a successful experience.

What exactly is Google Apps for Education?

Google Apps for Education is a free web-based suite of applications for schools to use. Students and teachers can create, share and store documents online to collaborate on projects and turn in assignments electronically. Students will have access to the Google Docs applications and an email account.

- Google Drive 30 GB cloud-based storage for files
- Google Docs –a word processing, spreadsheet, and presentation toolset similar to Microsoft Office
- Google Calendar online calendar to organize schedules, daily activities, assignments
- Google E-Mail managed by Mansfield ISD Technology, student emails will not be made public, nor will Google be provided any personal information

Examples of student use including showcasing class projects, building an electronic portfolio of school learning experiences, and working in small collaborative groups on presentations to share with others.

What Are the Benefits of Google Apps for Education?

- Anytime, anywhere access Google Apps works in any web browser, on any computer, which
 means users can access their documents, calendars, and e-mail from school, at home, or
 anywhere there is Internet access.
- Students have the ability to use and experience current technology applications and tools.
- Google Apps for Education allows for easy collaboration among students and teachers.
- Teachers have the ability to be involved via technology throughout the whole assignment process by providing comments and feedback directly in student documents.

Guidelines for Responsible Use of Google Apps for Education for students:

- Official E-mail Address: All students will be assigned a <u>username@misdmail.net</u> account in order to use MISD Google Apps for Education. Email account descriptions for K-12 are below*.
- **Prohibited Conduct:** Please refer to the MISD Acceptable Use Policy.
- Access Restriction Access to and use of student Google Apps for Education is considered a
 privilege accorded at the discretion of Mansfield ISD. The District maintains the right to

- immediately withdraw the access and use of these services including email when there is reason to believe the violations of the law or District policies have occurred. In such cases, the alleged violation will be referred to a Site Administrator for further investigation and adjudication.
- **Security**: Mansfield ISD cannot guarantee the security of electronic files located on Google systems. Although Google does have a powerful content filter in place for email, the District cannot assure that users will not be exposed to unsolicited information.
- Privacy: The general right of privacy will be extended to the extent possible in the electronic environment. Mansfield ISD and all electronic users should treat electronically stored information in individual's files as confidential and private. However, users of student email are strictly prohibited from accessing files and information other than their own. The District reserves the right to access the username@misdmail.net Google systems when there is reasonable suspicion that unacceptable use has occurred.

E-Mail Account Information*:

- Students in grades 6-12 will have access to both Google App accounts and Internet (INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE DISTRICT) email accounts.
- Under FERPA, a student's information is protected from disclosure to third parties
- Students will need to use this email address to create an Apple ID in order to use the iPad and download District purchased apps. This is notification that ALL 6th-12th grade students will have email accounts that can send and receive email from INSIDE and OUTSIDE THE DISTRICT.

Google's Commitment to the Educational Domains:

- Google Apps for Education is AD-FREE Mansfield ISD content is not processed by Google's advertising systems.
- Protection of the intellectual property on the servers is critically important to Google
- Google Apps brings you the latest technologies and some of the best practices for user privacy.
 - Apps content belongs to the individual users at your school, not Google.
 - We don't look at your content. Google employees must have explicit permission even for troubleshooting.
 - We don't share your content. Google does not share personal information without your consent.
 - We sometimes scan content for spam filtering, anti-virus protection, or malware detection.
